

Privacy Notice for HollanderParts.com and Storefront

EFFECTIVE DECEMBER 31, 2021

This notice of Hollander, LLC (referred to as “Hollander”, “we”, “us” or “our” in this privacy notice) explains how we collect and process personal data through your use of HollanderParts.com and Storefront websites displaying this notice. This notice should be read in conjunction with our Privacy Policy. Solera respects your privacy and is committed to providing information about personal data collected and processed by our company. This privacy notice may be updated by us from time to time.

Our websites are not intended for minors under the age of 16 and we do not knowingly collect data relating to children.

COLLECTION OF PERSONAL DATA

These websites collect personal information about authorized users of the services such as individuals or companies purchasing recycled parts. We receive information directly from the buyers. We collect the information to provide the services and to assist our customers with providing services to their end users. We also use the information to improve our products and services. We share the personal information with our customers of these websites, vendors who assist us in providing this service or our business, and government and regulatory authorities (where required). We do not sell personal data.

- **Identification Data** includes data such as a name, alias, postal address, unique personal identifier, online identifier, email address, account name, social security number, driver’s license number, passport number, or other similar identifiers.
- **Commercial Transaction Information** includes data such as records of personal property, products or services purchased, obtained, or considered, or other purchasing or consuming histories or tendencies.
- **Vehicle Data** includes data such as vehicle registration and licensure, vehicle identification number, vehicle pictures, damage info and repair and maintenance records.
- **Technical Data** includes data such as internet protocol address, login data, browser type and version, time zone setting, data on devices used to access the website, browsing history, search history, and information regarding interaction with an internet website, application, or advertisement.
- **Usage Data** includes data such as how you use our website or service.

Aggregated Data, such as statistical or demographic data, may be derived from your personal data but is not considered personal data in law as it does **not** directly or indirectly identify you.

IF YOU FAIL TO PROVIDE PERSONAL DATA

Where we need to collect personal data to provide this service or where required by law and you fail to provide that data when requested, we may not be able to perform the contract we have or are trying to enter into with you (for example, to provide you with services). In this case, we may have to cancel a product or service you have with us, but we will notify you if this is the case at the time.

DATA SECURITY

We have put in place appropriate security measures to prevent your personal data from being accidentally lost, used or accessed in an unauthorised way, altered or disclosed. In addition, we limit access to your personal data to those employees, agents, contractors and other third parties who have a business need-to-know. They will only process your personal data on our instructions, and they are subject to a duty of confidentiality.
